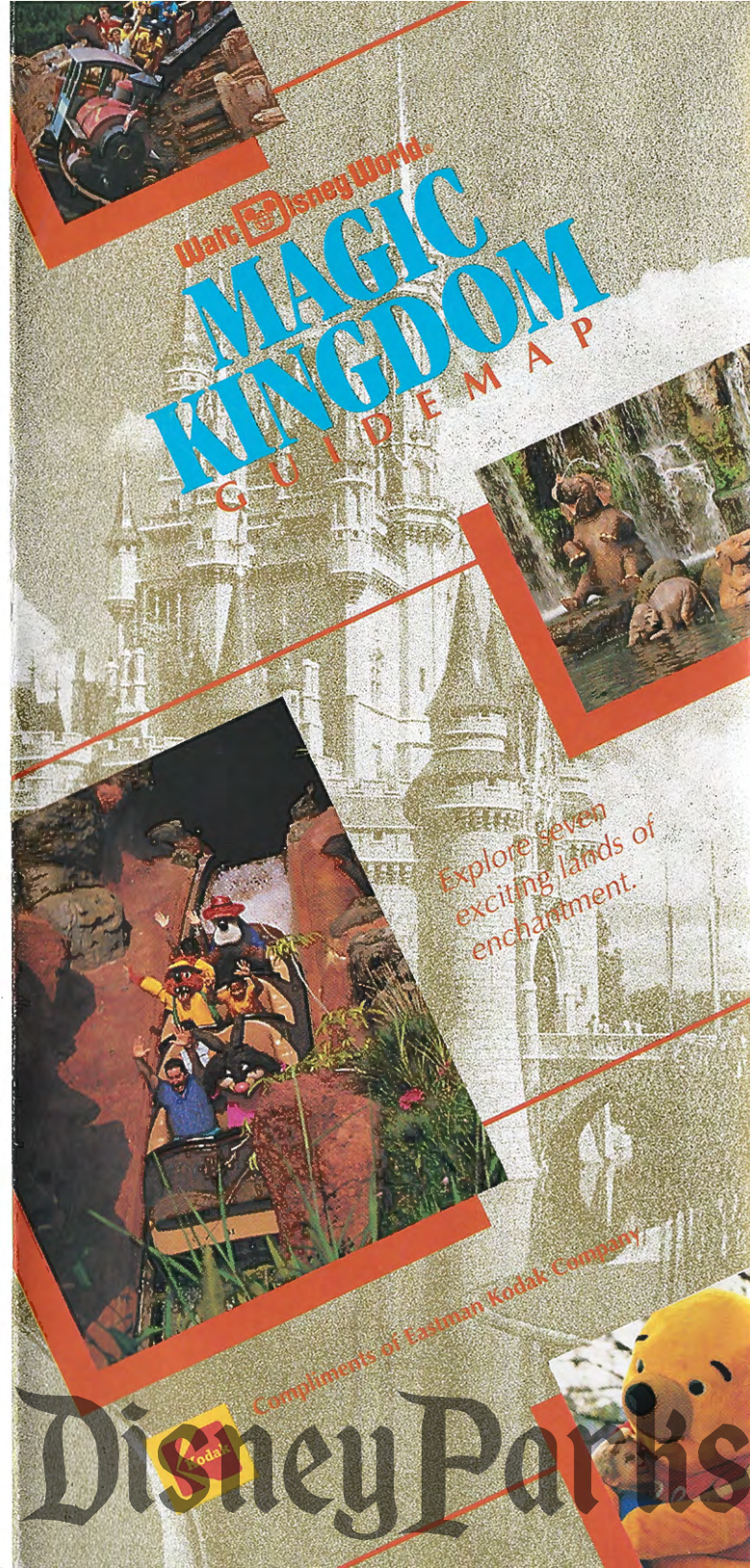

- Pick up an entertainment schedule at City Hall in Town Square, or at any shop. It gives the times and locations for today's live shows.
- To see a live performance of the **Diamond Horseshoe Jamboree** in Frontierland, make reservations immediately. They're taken on a first-come, first-served basis at Disneyana Collectibles on Main Street, U.S.A. Sandwiches, snacks and soft drinks are available before the show.
- Eat your lunch and dinner early or late to avoid peak hours at restaurants. Restaurants are listed by "Lands" in this Guide.
- Visit shops on Main Street, U.S.A. early in the afternoon.

Baby Strollers – Rentals available in limited quantities at the Stroller Shop just inside the Magic Kingdom entrance.

Banking – Full-service banking, including foreign currency exchange, is offered from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Sun Bank, N.A., located just inside the Magic Kingdom entrance.

Camera Center – Located on Main Street, U.S.A. Camera and camcorder rentals are available. For **Two-Hour Photo Processing**, drop your film where you see the PHOTO EXPRESS sign. Pick up prints at the Camera Center as you leave.

Credit Cards – The American Express® Card is the Official Card of the Walt Disney World Resort. Traveler's checks, cash, MasterCard® and Visa® are also accepted.

Dress – Proper dress is required. Shirt and shoes must be worn at all times.



First Aid – Located next to The Crystal Palace restaurant on Main Street, U.S.A.

Kennels – Pet care facilities available near the Transportation and Ticket Center. Presented by Friskies.

Lockers – Available under the Main Street Railroad Station and at the Transportation and Ticket Center.

Picnics – Food and drink may not be brought into the Magic Kingdom.



Wheelchairs – Available for rent in limited quantities at the Stroller Shop just inside the Magic Kingdom Entrance.

Reservations for next-day use of an Electric Convenience Vehicle can be made by calling Walt Disney World Information at 824-4321. To assist **guests needing wheelchairs**, this guide uses a wheelchair symbol ♿ to indicate areas where guests may remain in their wheelchairs at all times. To experience attractions marked with this symbol, ♿ → ♿ guests in motorized vehicles must transfer to an available wheelchair. This symbol ♿ means guests must leave wheelchairs to enter the attraction. For additional help, ask for a "Guidebook for Guests with Disabilities" at City Hall.

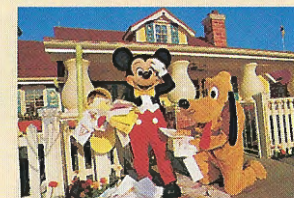
FILM SPEED AND USES

Kodak offers several film types so you can plan out your "day in film" and be ready for all the Walt Disney World photo fun!

400 Kodak Gold Ultra 400 is an enhanced multi-purpose film for a wider range of light and action. It's Kodak's most versatile film. Great for clear shots of moving objects and in low light conditions. *Examples: Live stage shows, Cinderella's Golden Carrousel at dusk, SpectroMagic.*



200 Kodak Gold Super 200 is a multi-purpose film for sunny or overcast days. *Examples: Daytime Parade, Mickey's house.*
